#### **Date and Location:**

The IMA Gasshuku is held at the Keystone Resort in Keystone, Colorado. The resort is located 80 miles west of Denver. The approximately two hour drive from Denver International Airport takes you into the Rocky Mountains along I-70 to Silverthorne, from where a ten minute drive east on Highway 6 will bring you to the resort. Check-in begins at 2:00 PM on Friday, September 27<sup>th</sup> with checkout being around 11:30 AM on Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. Training will start promptly at 7:30 PM on Friday in full gi. Please refer to the schedule for exact locations of classes.

Participants and guests coming from out-of-state should be sure to arrive in Denver no later than noon on September 27<sup>th</sup>. If possible, arrive the night before and enjoy an extra day in the beautiful Colorado mountains. **Please schedule your return flight to leave late on Sunday or Monday**. Participants who live locally should leave home no later than 3:00 PM on Friday due to traffic on I-70.

#### **Keystone Facilities:**

The Keystone Resort offers countless activities such as 40 miles of paved paths for walking or biking, pools and hot tubs, a scenic gondola ride, horseback riding, shops, restaurants, golf, whitewater rafting, and much more.
