Dates and Location:

The Rocky Mountain Gasshuku is returning to The Inn at Silver Creek in Granby, Colorado. The Inn at SilverCreek is 110 miles west of Denver International Airport. The approximately two-hour drive from the airport along I-70 and US-40 West takes you into the Rocky Mountains on your way to Granby. Check-in time begins at 4:00 PM on Friday, September 30th with checkout being 11:00 AM on Sunday, October 2nd. (Guest Services Department provides luggage storage for guests arriving early or “attending functions on the day of their departure”). Training will start promptly at 7:00 PM on Friday in full gi. Please refer to the schedule for exact locations of classes.

Participants and guests coming from out-of-state should be sure to arrive in Denver no later than noon on September 30th. **A free IMA shuttle will be provided for those who arrive by 10 AM.** Arriving the day before and enjoying the beautiful Colorado Mountains is a great option. **Please schedule your return flight late Sunday.**

Participants who live locally should leave home no later than 3:00 PM on Friday due to traffic on I-70.

Facilities:

The Inn at SilverCreek provides world-class Granby Colorado lodging in the heart of Grand County. It is perfectly staged for easy access to Winter Park and Sol Vista Basin, scenic Rocky Mountain National Park, championship golf, world-class mountain biking and a wonderful array of dining and shopping options.

Reservation and Rates:

It is recommended that each individual (or family) planning to attend the Gasshuku call The Inn at SilverCreek to make their own reservations. This will enable each family or individual to satisfy their particular needs and desires for accommodations. In order to receive the special rate, it is necessary to call reservations and mention that you are with “**RMG**” (Rocky Mountain Gasshuku). We have a selection of rooms blocked until September 1, 2016 at

the following prices: King at \$72, Studio (Sleeps 2 to 4) at \$82, Loft (Sleeps 4 to 6) at \$102, Studio Suite (King connected to a Studio) at \$128 and Master Suite (King connected to a Loft) at \$145. **YOU MUST CALL to make the reservation with our group rate.** After September 1, 2016, the rooms will be released into general inventory. You may continue to book at the discounted group rate **based on availability** until your day of arrival. The number of participants at our camp has been growing every year and we are expecting many more participants than previous years. There are a limited number of discounted rooms so **please make your reservations as soon as you possible.**

Please be advised: The training fee is separate from room and board. Please make your check to “IMA”, and include it with your registration form to **1340 Main Street, Louisville, Colorado 80027, USA.** There is a \$30 late fee if submitted after September 23, 2016.

Training Rooms:

Training will be held in five separate training areas, with students separated into five levels. **Please check your name/s in the front of each rooms on Saturday**

- Group #1** Black belt 35 yrs. old and above
- Group #2** Black belt 34 yrs. old and younger
- Group #3** Jr. black belt, 1st and 2nd kyu - 10 yrs. old and above
- Group #4** All levels up to 3rd kyu - 10 yrs. old and above
- Group #5** All levels - 9 yrs. old and younger
